### Summary of Most Recent Site Inspection

The school facility is inspected each year by district staff. In addition, a safety inspection is performed by the Humboldt County Office of Education's Safety Coordinator every three years. The most recent safety inspection was December, 2007.

### Repairs Needed

- Heating and Ventilation System needs replacement/upgrading.
- Boy's Bathroom in main building has leak in drain pipe in one urinal.
  - Roof in Main Building in need of repair/replacement.

### Corrective Actions Taken or Planned

- HVAC System is scheduled for replacement in summer, 2008, under a extreme hardship deferred maintenance grant.
- Boy's Bathroom in main building has leak in drain pipe; repairs are expected in 2008 as a deferred maintenance item.
- Roof in Main Building in need of repair; several leaks have been patched during the winter rains. A proposal for an extreme hardship grant to replace the roof is being prepared for submission in 2008.
